

Pro Tools Setup Guide

This is a quick and simple guide to setting up your USB GO BOX Mk2 in Pro Tools. The USB GO BOX can be used with various pieces of software on both PC and Mac, but we are often asked to explain the setup processes in Pro Tools. That Little Box is in no way associated with Avid.

Using GO BOX Control Panel (available on the website), the settings application that works with your USB GO BOX Mk2, you can assign MIDI Machine Control Commands to buttons on your GO BOX. You can then use those commands to control Pro Tools.

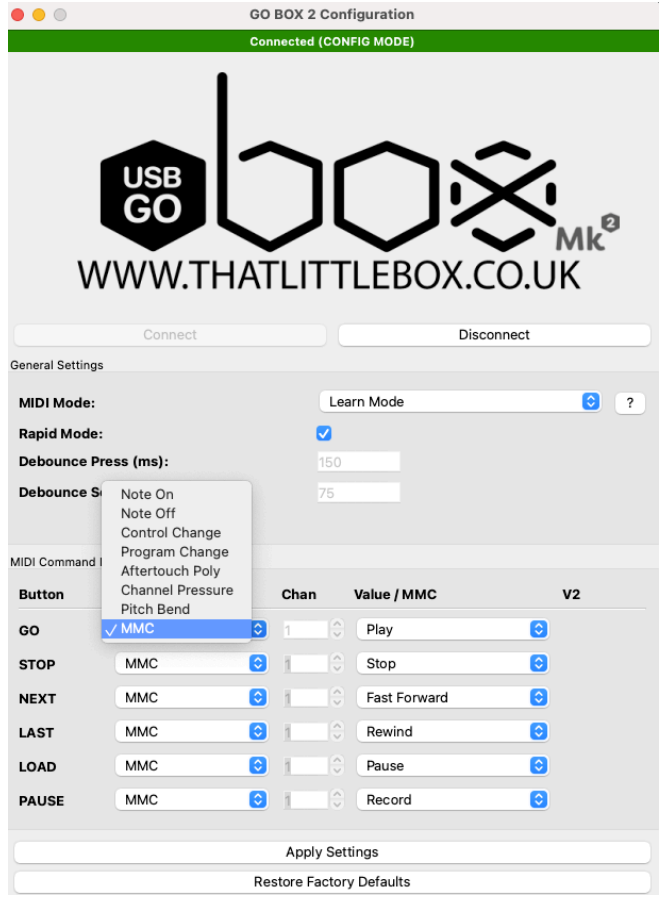
Set up your GO BOX

Open GO BOX Control Panel. Connect your USB GO BOX to your computer using Port 1 (the one above the yellow button). Once plugged in, press the Connect button in GO BOX Control Panel. The status bar will go green to confirm connection.

Set the MIDI Mode to Learn Mode.

In the MIDI Command Editor, set the "Type" of each button's MIDI message to MMC, then set each command from the list in "Value"

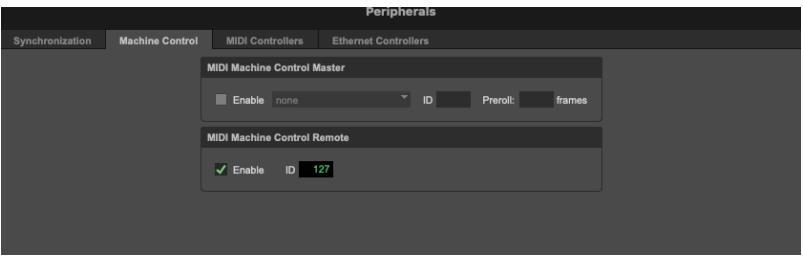
once you are finished, hit Apply settings and disconnect GO BOX Control Panel from your GO BOX.



Set up Pro Tools

In Pro Tools, navigate to the setup menu and select Peripherals.

In the resulting window, select the Machine Control Tab and enable MIDI Machine Control Remote. ID can be left as 127.



Your GO BOX should now control Pro Tools.
